In this presentation, Dr Fleming will lead us through a sustained reflection on excellence and ethics in end of life care. His particular focus arises out months of divisive debate about what should – and shouldn't – be part of end of life care in Victoria, which ultimately led to the passing of the "Voluntary Assisted Dying" Act. This same debate is currently being replicated around the country. In this oration, Dr Fleming will consider some of the ethical issues that we encounter in the area of end of life care and prompt us to consider what this means in our profession. He will walk us through Victoria's new legislation and its implications for health services, and ultimately invite us to consider what beautiful and excellent care might look like for those who are near to the end of their lives.

About the Orator: Dr Dan Fleming

Dr Dan Fleming is Group Manager – Ethics and Formation for St Vincent's Health Australia, a role which sees him leading ethics education, advice and strategy as well as supporting formation across the St Vincent's Health Australia network. Dan is also a Fellow in the Law, Health and Justice Research Centre in the Faculty of Law at the University of Technology Sydney, and a Senior Lecturer in Theology and Ethics with the Sydney College of Divinity. He chairs the Catholic Health Australia taskforce which has been set up to provide leadership across the Catholic Health and Aged Care sectors in responding to Victoria's 'Voluntary Assisted Dying' Act. Dan holds a PhD in moral philosophy and theology and is the author of over 30 publications in the areas of moral philosophy, theological ethics, moral education, religious education and theology. His forthcoming book 'Attentiveness to Vulnerability' is due to be released in 2018. Dan is well-known for his innovative and engaging presentation style, and his capacity to open up space for high quality ethical discussions.
