**We offer the standard Introductory Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) program (40 hours)**

Basic Clinical Pastoral Education in Mental Health Ministry (400 hours). This unit will be conducted:

- Venue: Macquarie Hospital, North Ryde – with supervised placements in the Northern Sydney Health Area
