Clinical Pastoral Education Programs offered by the Mental Health CPE Centre

in 2021

The Mental Health CPE Centre is teaching Foundational (previously “Basic”, 400 hour) and Introductory programs of CPE again in 2021. The Foundational Units specialise in ***Aged Care Ministry at St Basils Aged Care Facility*** at Lakemba; ***Mental Health Ministry at Macquarie and Cumberland Psychiatric Hospitals***, and in the ***Mental Health Units at Hornsby/ Kuringai Hospital***. The 40 hour Introductory CPE program can be taken on its own or as preparation for the Foundational Unit at Lakemba, Hornsby and Cumberland.

Foundational CPE in Aged Care Ministry 8.45-3.15, 25 Tuesdays 4th May to 16th November, missing school holidays, at St Basil’s Aged Care Facility, Lakemba, starts with the Introductory segment on Tuesdays at Hornsby Hospital, or Thursdays at Cumberland Hospital.

Foundational CPE in Mental Health Ministry at Macquarie Hospital, North Ryde, 8.00 am to 3 pm, 25 Wednesdays, 3rd March to 22nd September, missing school holidays

Foundational CPE in Mental Health Ministry at Hornsby Hospital (following the Introductory CPE) 8.45am to 4.00 pm on 25 Wednesdays, 6th May to 18th November, missing school holidays

Foundational CPE in Mental Health Ministry at Cumberland Psychiatric Hospital, Westmead (after the Intro CPE) 8.45am to 4.00 pm on 25 Thursdays, 6th May to 18th November, missing school holidays.

A Foundational CPE for Korean Students is organised by the Iona/Columba Korean College, with lectures and resource material translated into Korean, on Wednesdays May to November 9 am to 12.30 at Rhodes, with supervised placements by arrangement, and follows the 40 hour Introductory segment at Rhodes on Wednesdays in March and April. The Iona College will be issuing their own prospectus for this program.

The 40 hour Introductory CPE Course introduces the practice of pastoral supervision; begins the process of theological and spiritual reflection; demonstrates the Action Reflection Model of supervised learning; and looks at the key elements of pastoral ministry in specific placements, general hospital, aged care, mental health, prison, school, church and in the community. It can be taken on its own or as preparation for the Foundational Units.

The fee for the Introductory Course is \$200, which includes the NSW CPE College Certificate Fee \$50.

The fee for the Foundational Unit is \$1750, which includes the CPE Certificate Fee \$150.

The Foundational Unit of CPE, limited to a maximum of 6 students, consists of:

100 hours of Group Supervision

150 hours of supervised placement, *including* ministry in the student’s own work place

10 hours of Individual Supervision with the supervisor

140 hours of preparation, research and reports in the student’s own time

It is undertaken as CPE 1 with a focus on the dynamics of pastoral conversation

then CPE 2 with a focus on methods of theological and spiritual reflection

and CPE 3 with a focus on ethical concerns in ministry in particular pastoral interactions

CPE 1, CPE 2, and CPE 3, each building on the previous unit, are **recognised subjects** for the Sydney College of Divinity Masters of Arts (Chaplaincy) and Masters of Arts (Pastoral Supervision).

Our Multi-Faith programs encourage participants, while firmly based in their own spiritual tradition, to acknowledge and learn from the rich heritage of people from other Faiths and other cultures.

The Mental Health CPE Centre runs **other Introductory CPE courses** for local hospitals and specific Spiritual Traditions by request. We are also available for individual supervision and group pastoral consultation.
